

16 April 2019







As reported last week, the course is closed for play until tomorrow 17 April 2018 due to work being done on the greens. As of tomorrow, temporary greens will be in play for a period of approximately 2/3 weeks.

#### **Arrangements while playing on temporary greens:**

- The following will be implemented as result of the temporary greens being located on the fairways short of the permanent greens, making each hole considerably shorter:
  - 1. The yellow tee box markers will be taken out of play.
  - 2. The Blue tee box markers will be moved to where the yellow markers were and the Red tee box markers will be moved where the Blue markers were.
  - 3. Therefore, the only markers in play will be Blue and Red and you will be required to play off your Blue or Red course handicap.
- The maximum 2 putt rule will apply on the temporary greens.
- As this is a temporary arrangement, the markers on the fairways, that indicate the distance to the center of the permanent green, will not be moved. Pin placement sheets will be provided that show the variance from the center of the permanent greens to the point in line with the flag (down the center of the fairway) on the temporary greens.

  Example: if for hole 1 the variance is -20 then the distance to the temp flag from the 150-meter mark on the fairway will be 150-20=130 meters to the flag. It will therefore be in your best interest to ensure you take a pin placement sheet.

- A player's handicap can go down and he/she will play off the lower handicap, but cannot go up during the course of the tournament.
- Tournament will start on 1 May and the prize giving will be in the 1° Saturday of December 2019.
- All administration for the event will be handled by ASM.
- Live scoring, results, and draws will be done via the ASM.
   App and be available to the players who are required to download the ASM app on their phones.
  - A full set of <u>Tournament Rules</u>, <u>Regulations and</u>
     <u>Conditions</u> will be put up on the notice boards and will be available from the office at the club.

#### Rules, Regulations and Conditions

- 1. Start date -1 May 2019
- 2. Final Prize Giving -Saturday 7 December 2019
- 3. Entry fee R50.00 per player, payable at the Proshop by 1 May 2019.
- 4. The format of the competition is single match play.
- 5. Competition is open to all Kuilsriver members including ladies
- 6. Dates for conclusion of rounds will be allocated as soon as entries close.
- 7. For this competition purpose only, all entrants handicap index will be frozen as at 1 May 2019.
- 8. Entrants divisions will be decided upon 6 above, as at 1 May 2019.
- 9. Entrants will only compete in their own division, as in A, B and C division.
- 10. Handicap index for the different divisions are as follows:
  - a. A -Division up to 9.1
  - b. B –Division 9.2 to 17.3
  - c. C –Division17.4andabove
- Entrants will remain in their allocated divisions for the duration of the competition irrespective of their handicap changes during the competition.
- 12. For the duration and purpose of this competition only, player's handicaps can go down but not up. The highest handicap a player can compete from is the handicap index as at 1 May 2019.
- 13. A player whose handicap becomes lower during the competition period will play off this lower handicap in the respective rounds in the competition.
- 14. Thus a player will play off their current handicap index at each round of the competition, unless that handicap is higher than the handicap index



of 1 May, in which case he/she will play off the handicap index of 1 May.

- 15. Tees to be played off:
  - a. A -Yellow
  - b. B-Blue
  - c. C-Red
- 16. It is the sole responsibility of **the player** to ensure you supply the result and find out against who and by when your next game must be completed. This information will be available on the ASM Golf App which can be downloaded on your phone.
- 17. It is the responsibility of both players to arrange their match before the cutoff date. Should this not happen it would lead to the disqualification of both players.
- 18. If a player wants to claim a match due to the opponent not adhering to rule 20 above, the player needs to supply the organizing committee with a trail as evidence.
- 19. 1<sup>st</sup> Round losers will play in their respective divisions in a plate competition.
- 20. If a match is tied after18 holes the players must continue until a winner is found.
- 21. Should it be impossible for the match to continue due to any reason the following count out procedure will apply.
  - a. Winner after 15 holes if still tied, winner after 12 holes if still tied, winner after 9 holes completed if still tied, winner after 6 holes completed if still tied, winner after 3 holes completed if still tied winner after 1 hole completed. If still tied the winner will be decided by toss of a coin.
- 22. A round will consist of a minimum of 9 holes to be played should it not be possible to complete 18 holes.
- 23. All communication, draws and results will be done via the ASM Golf App. Players are strongly advised to download the app in order to stay updated with the progress of the event.
- 24. ASM will sponsor prizes for the winners of A,B and C divisions both in the Cup and the Plate Divisions.
- 25. TheOrganizers –African Sports Management (Pty) Ltd, reserve the right to change, amend or add any rules, regulations and conditions they deem required necessary to ensure the successful running of the Tournament.



- 26. The tournament committee will consist of members of African Sports Management, whose decision shall be final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- 27. By entering the event players confirm that they will abide and accept the rules as set out in the TOURNAMENT RULES, REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS.
