MONTHLY GOLF TIP FROM OUR RESIDENT PGA PROFESSIONAL THYS POTGIETER...

Question: I keep missing short and medium length putts I expect to hole. What could I be doing wrong?

Answer: The two main reasons for missing a putt are a misjudgement of pace and line or moving excessively during the stroke. It's crucial to stay sill on a putt and minimize the amount of moving parts if you're to keep the blade square to the target. If you're too eager to follow the progress of the ball towards the hole, it's all too easy to come off the shot. Even from a good set-up, watching the clubhead on the backswing can lead to this jerky action as you tend to look at the club throughout the stroke. Your head and shoulders start to lift up just before impact. The blade doesn't stay square through impact and you either push or pull the ball.

Pendulum putt

A good putting stroke is based on a pendulum action of your arms and shoulders while keeping your wrists firm.



- Resist the temptation to look up and follow the ball.
- Don't move your head or raise your shoulders until well after ball is on its way.
- Swing with a slow smooth rhythm and be firm through the stroke.
- Don't jerk the putter back after impact hold the follow-through position.

LOCAL RULE (ELECTRIC FENCE)

E-7 Relief from Electric Boundary Fence

<u>Purpose.</u> -Where an electric fence is used as a boundary fence, a Local Rule providing free relief for a ball lying within a certain distance (for example, two club-lengths) of the boundary fence is permitted. In these circumstances, to ensure the safety of the player, the player can measure.
